JUNIOR WORLD CHAMPION ALEX SELLECK

Alex Selleck, the son of GTD's AJ Selleck, is said to be the Youngest Jr Dragster world champion and that record will likely stand for many years to come. Alex is only in his 2nd year of racing and has already claimed his 2nd track championship this year in the 'Beginners' class.

The track crowns a Junior Dragster track champion in each age category. Each track within the World Drag Racing Alliance (WDRA) sends one Junior racer to represent their home track and compete at the WDRA World Final. MMM had a runoff to allow each driver to try to earn that spot. FYI, the WDRA World Finals has 4 separate racing classes, racers from Michigan made up 4 of the 8 drivers in the final rounds.

Alex (at 8 years old) was able to get wins against both older champions, securing his spot to represent MMM at the World Finals in Darlington S.C. At the world finals, 28 Junior Racers from the US and Canada assembled to race for the Championship.

Each racer earned the right to be there by winning their track championship or winning at their division finals. Most all these racers were comprised of 13–17-year-old 'Advanced' competitors. Alex was able to turn on the win lights in the first 4 rounds against some tough racers and moves onto the final round.
