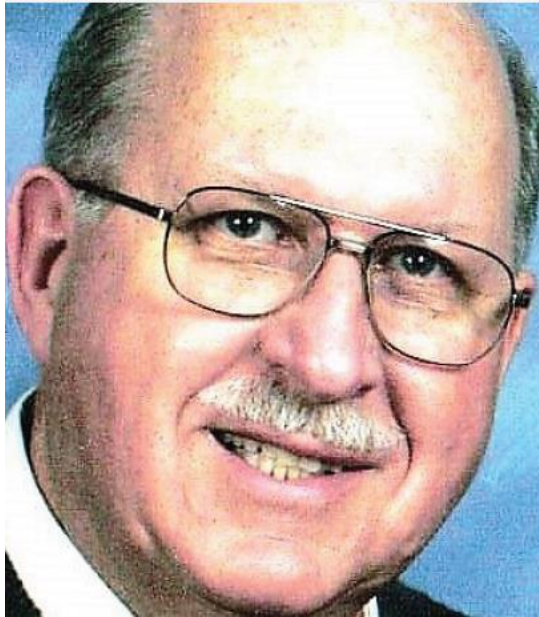
The Surveillance Audit of our Quality System resulted in "0" Corrective Action Requests being written. Congratulations and thank you employees for your continued commitment to quality.
